

Asian Timeline Project

1. Assignment: Select an **Asian Timeline subject from the chapter** and complete the following requirements.

- a. Conduct in-depth research of the topic
- b. Prepare and submit a written report or Presentation

2. General: Groups may include up to 3 members. Students may complete this assignment as individuals. Each group will select a unique Time period on an Asian Timeline to research. Topics must be approved prior to beginning research, as no groups in a class will select the same topic.

3. Content.

a) Reports may include, but not limited to:

- Nature of topic
- Identify the time period
- Geographically (where did it occur)
- Origin of topic (history/significant accomplishments)
- Group goals/objectives (what it wants to accomplish)
- Group membership (demographics/characteristics)
- Political ideology and political party affiliation, if appropriate
- Issues supported/opposed
- Finances (how money is raised and spent)
- Activities to support goals
- The topic related to current events

b) A visual aid is required for the oral presentation

4. Resources. Possible resources include, but are not limited to: World History textbook, library books/magazines, internet, and the history books themselves.

5. Grading (50 points possible)

a. Written Report **OR** Presentation

1) Paper

- i. Prepare a summary for the Asian (minimum one full page to maximum two full pages) One paper per group
- ii. The report should be typed, double spaced and neatly organized. (grammar, punctuation)
- iii. Prepare a title page with the name of your topic and the listing of the group members.
- iv. The report should include at least one visual aid in report.

2) Presentation

- i. Prepare a presentation and summary for the Asian timeline (minimum two full minutes to maximum four full minutes) One presentation per group
- ii. The report should include at least one visual aid in report.
- iii. Every group member must actively participate in the group's presentation
